Dear Colleagues,

We had some technical issues with the [Second Announcement](#) sent last week, therefore we are sending this **Third Announcement** to ensure that as many colleagues as possible receive it.

We are very excited that **more than 250 people** have **already expressed their interest** in attending the **16th International Luminescence and Electron Spin Resonance Dating conference (LED2021)** that will be held online this September. If you have not already added your e-mail address to the circulation list then please do so using the [online form](#). To help ensure that you receive messages from **LED2021** we would also suggest that you **whitelist the conference's e-mail address** conference@led2021.org to prevent your spam filter and firewall settings from blocking any future communications. Also, please check your spam and junk folders in case the previous announcements are still there and allow them into your inbox. If your email account is institutional, check with your IT person that the server's internal firewall allows for the same email from a singular third party to go to and from the same domain to multiple people within the organisation at the same time. Free email providers tend to throttle delivery, delaying email reception up to 48 hours. Last but not least and as a last resort, as we are using a mass-email service platform (MailChimp) to send conference communications, you (or your IT person) could add MailChimp's [IP delivery addresses](#) to your allowlist to ensure receiving our emails.

With this **Third Announcement** we would also like to inform that we are **extending the Abstract Submission deadline to the end of Monday 14th June 2021**. As described in the [Second Announcement](#), all abstracts for **LED2021** should be submitted via the **Abstract Submission Portal**. Each delegate may only submit **ONE abstract**, and they must present this work themselves (either as a poster or a talk) at the conference.
