We are sending you this e-mail because you submitted an abstract that was accepted for presentation at [LED2021](#).

During the [LED2021 Business Meeting](#), it was suggested that all International LED **Conference Abstracts**, i.e., the **Book of Abstracts**, be published as a **Special Issue of Ancient TL**. This was mentioned in the [Final Reminders](#) infographic sent to all delegates on the "*Thank You for being part of LED2021*" e-mail sent yesterday 27 September 2021.

The idea behind this great suggestion is twofold:

- *All accepted and presented abstracts would be easily available to the entire LED Community.*
- *This would reinforce the value of Ancient TL as our Community's main communication & outreach platform.*

As this idea was brought up during the Conference, it was not announced prior to the [LED2021](#) Abstract Submission.

We already discussed this suggestion with the Editors-in-Chiefs of both [Radiation Measurements](#) and [Quaternary Geochronology](#), the two journals where the [LED2021 Conference Proceedings](#) are to be published, and they assured us that there are no copyright issues as long as **Ancient TL publishes the SAME ABSTRACT that was submitted to LED2021.**

The intention is to publish all accepted abstracts for presented orals or posters. No changes in titles or abstracts will be allowed.
